HACKNEY'S LUNCH CLUBS



Hackney CVS contacted their lunch clubs as most have now closed. They asked the clubs if:

- they can continue to make lunches and deliver them to their members
- the members have family support or need support
- the luncheon space could be used by others who are co-ordinating local food efforts.

Feedback suggested that lunch clubs are in telephone contact with their members to checkhow they are coping and support their mental wellbeing.

<u>Halkevi Lunch Club</u> have linked up with local Turkish shops to arrange deliveries totheir members.

Nightingale are dropping off ready meals to the members daily.

Holly Street and Chats members all have family support.

Salvation Army are providing shopping runs for their members.

<u>Hackney Cypriot</u> potentially have a number of the members who will need further support.
